

Thanks so much for your interest in our treatment approach to DIABETES.

We've published our results for *diabetic kidney failure*, which you can download from our website at <http://www.genomed.com/pdf/diabetes.technology.therapeutics.pdf> (This is a large file because it has colored graphs; you'll need a fast Internet connection, like a DSL line, to download it).

If begun early, before a person has lost more than half of their kidney function, our treatment approach can PREVENT having to go on the kidney machine.

Since we have over 3,000 patient-years' experience already, and since it has been published, it is no longer a trial, but rather "state of the art." Our policy is to run trials for free, but to charge a Disease Management fee once a treatment has been published in a peer-reviewed medical journal. ***Our annual fee is \$200 (payable by check or credit card).***

Unfortunately, the patient still has to pay out of their own pocket. ***Insurance won't yet cover our fee.***

We'd love to work with your current physician, in which case he/she will receive \$20 for their participation in our Clinical Outcomes Improvement Program (COIP[®]). If you don't have a physician who wants to participate, we might be able to find one for you locally among the physicians already working with us. As a last resort, you could always come to my office in St. Louis to get started. I charge \$100 extra for each office visit.
